Our unique difference is that we are not a single plan or insurance company but a managed care network and medical management company. *Arizona Foundation* works directly with insurance professionals, such as brokers, consultants and general agents, as well as third party administrators and insurance companies.

Plans to Fit Every Need

Arizona Foundation plans include Foundation PPO, Foundation EPO/PPO Plus, Foundation Point of Service, Foundation Select and Foundation Comp. *Arizona Foundation* also offers a comprehensive package of medical management services that include: Utilization Management, Case Management, Disease Management and Maternity Management plus a comprehensive Wellness Program.

Cost Effective

Arizona Foundation's fee schedule is determined by an Independent Reimbursement Committee, comprised of employer group representatives who are elected each year from employer groups using *Arizona Foundation* endorsed or sponsored plans and three non-member physicians. The Committee meets several times a year to review, amend and set procedure allowances. Fees are determined using a set of criteria that includes but is not limited to RBRVS data. The *Arizona Foundation's* fee schedule averages approximately 35% off of billed charges and is 20% less than the 2003 Medicare Fee Schedule.
